# TRAIN THE TRAINER: TRAINING TECHNIQUES

Saturday, June 8–Sunday, June 9, 2024

New York, NY 8:30 a.m.–5:30 p.m.

This workshop is designed to take IATSE workers who are experts in their craft who are or will be training at their local and teaches them education and training techniques to improve their presentation and sharpen their skills as teachers.

This two-day, in-person course is a general workshop on how to prepare for and conduct successful training. Topics such as classroom management skills and presentation techniques, effective instruction, and adult learning theory will be addressed. Participants will get to directly apply and practice using these skills during the workshop with a short 15-minute section of a specific course they teach or are familiar with as a trainer.

This course is intended for trainers who will be using the OSHA 10-Hour General Industry with Focus on the Entertainment Industry, OSHA 30-Hour General Industry with Focus on the Entertainment Industry, OSHA 10-Hour Construction with Focus on the Entertainment Industry, OSHA 30-Hour Construction with Focus on the Entertainment Industry, or IATSE TTF Safety First! Curriculum and those conducting safety or craft skills training for their local.

Local unions are invited to select up to three IATSE workers from their local to attend our two-day, customized Train the Trainer workshop. Select experienced local trainers or IATSE workers who you want to develop as new safety or craft skills trainers for your local. *If you are a Training Director, Training Coordinator, and/or other officer responsible for coordinating training at your local but do not teach craft skills and/or safety courses at the local, you are welcome to attend this course, so you also know and understand the training methods being shared with trainers.*

A TTF Beneficiary is an individual who is an active IATSE member or is working under an IATSE agreement.

Space is limited in this training, and locals are invited to submit up to three applicants for this workshop, which may include a Training Director, Training Coordinator, and/or other officer responsible for training at the local but who does not teach safety and/or craft skills courses at the local so they know and understand the training methods being shared with trainers. Once your application is received and seats are confirmed, you and the applicants you have selected will receive confirmation emails.

The two-day workshop itself is free of charge for participants. The IATSE Training Trust Fund cannot, however, cover the costs for travel, lodging\*, meals, or per diems associated with travel or participation in this workshop. \*The TTF has a hotel subsidy available to qualifying locals.
